COVID-19 Guest Expectations

In adherence to the Centers for Disease Control recommendations in protecting yourself and limiting the spread of COVID-19, all guests will be expected to:

Stay home if you:

- If you are experiencing any symptoms of COVID-19; Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, Fever, Chills, Muscle pain, Sore throat, New loss of taste or smell
- If within 48 hours you have been in contact with anyone who has tested positive for Coronavirus

Face coverings are required

- Face covers must always be worn in our indoor facilities
- Face covers must always be worn outside when in the base area, lift lines and on lifts

Valid resort access (day ticket, a season pass, Woodward or tubing ticket) is required to enter the base area including all indoor facilities

- Base lodges will be open for restrooms, rentals, and retail and 20 minute warming zones

No indoor dining will be available

- Face masks are required to be worn at all times while indoors, therefore all food and beverage consumption will be directed to outdoor areas and personal vehicles

On entering Woodward Tahoe Bunker facility, guests are required to participate in a wellness screening

- Screening questionnaire
- Temperature check

Continue to practice heightened hygiene practices

- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds
- If soap and water are not readily available, use a hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Cover all surfaces of your hands and rub them together until they feel dry. We have made “Sanitization Stations” available at many areas around our resorts
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands

Avoid close contact and adhere to physical distancing

- Follow all programming and facility specific guest policies supporting physical distancing while onsite
- Stay at least 6 feet (about 2 arms’ length) from other people
- Do not gather in groups
- Stay out of crowded places

Capacity limitations

- Upon opening, capacities in our venues, chairlifts, programming sessions, food and beverage outlets, experiences and other offerings may be modified and limited in capacity and subject to limited availability or closure, based on direction from health experts and government officials to promote physical distancing
